The Warren County High School Trap League had its first shoot of the season in tough conditions on Tuesday.

Warren, Corry and Eisenhower were able to pull out wins in the wind and rain with five of the 210 shooters scoring perfect 25s.

Jarrett Brown shot a 25 to lead Warren in a 167-165 victory over Youngsville. He was followed by Jacob Fankhouser, Ben Nutt, Matthew Ristau and Blake Ristau, all with 24. Seth Ecelberger had a 25 for Youngsville with Trevor Gustafson, Nathan Lehman and Ethan Maskier finishing one shot back.

Dillon Cross and Brady Bowen both recorded 25s to help Corry beat Sheffield by a final score of 168-153. Michael Dietz, Lucas Mitchell and Logan Muir all shot 24s for Corry while Emily Grove's 24 was the top score for Sheffield and earned her the title of high lady.

Eisenhower beat Tidioute 156-132 led by Dominick Giannini's 25. Ryan Williams shot 23 in the loss for Tidioute.

The same three teams won their JV matchups with Corry's Nick Lapinski finishing with the top individual score of 23. Pierce Landis led Warren with a 21, Marissa Grubbs had a 20 for Sheffield, Kyle Coons shot a 17 for Eisenhower, and Youngsville's Sadie Hoffman and Tidioute's Kelsey Nuttall both finished with 16s.
