Youngsville outgunned Eisenhower 156-154 behind 24s from Ian Proctor and Cody Haight as well as a 23 from Jake McChesney. Chris Kibbey led Eisenhower with a 24 while Chris Anthony and Jeremy Carlson each shot 23.

Warren White defeated Tidioute by a final score of 148-144. Logan Galloway shot a 23 to lead the winners while Andrew Egger and Tyler Watson each finished with a 22. Mike Ziegler's perfect 25 paced Tidioute with Hannah Divido and Dakota Gourley adding 21s.

On a bye week, Sheffield shot the league's third highest score with a 159. Mason Albaugh busted all 25 targets while Nate Benson finished with a 24 and Emily Grove with a 23. Grove's score also made her this week's high lady, finishing a shot over Warren Blue's Callie Hampson.

Corry, Warren White and Eisenhower were winners in JV action, and Corry's Brady Bowen had the highest JV score with his 22.
