Corry wins trap league title in shoot-off

When the pressure was on, Corry's shooters delivered in a big way.

The Beavers busted 173 out of a possible 175 targets to win the Warren County High School Trap League title in a shoot-off with Warren Blue and Youngsville, which tied for second with matching scores of 165. Those three teams finished the regular season tied for first, forcing a shoot-off to be held during the annual field day competition on Tuesday.

Dillon Cross, Michael Dietz, Tagen Dingfelder, Logan Muir and Hunter Tasker all finished with perfect scores to lead Corry while Brady Bowen and Jonah Fronk added 24s.

Max Sobina hit all 25 for Warren Blue while John Fankhouser and Matt Sweigart hit 24 each. Then came Andrew Anderson, Jarrett Brown, Jacob Fankhouser and Matt McDunn - all with 23s.

For Youngsville, Nathen Carr's perfect score was followed by 24s from Dalton Abrams and Ian Proctor. Nathan Coan, Jimmy Cowan, Seth Ecelberger and Jordan Keyes added 23s.

As part of the field day competition, a total of 204 of the league's 236 shooters competed for individual prizes in one of ten classes based on their average. Results are as follows:
